Theatres Trust Theatre Reopening Fund

The Albert Hall is extremely thankful to the Theatres Trust, after being awarded £2,835 from their Theatre Reopening Fund.

The Albert Hall, Llandrindod Wells has recently been awarded £2,835 from the national public advisory body for theatre, Theatres Trust. Theatres Trust have awarded over £300,000, of grants to theatres around the UK, through their Theatre Reopening Fund.

The Albert Hall is a grade 2 listed Victorian theatre, and improvements will be made to the front of house, to make it COVID secure, and to support social distancing.

Jon Williams, chair of The Albert Hall Management Committee said, "We are extremely grateful to the Theatres Trust for awarding us this funding. It will allow us to make changes needed for the future. These will enable social distancing within front of house and queuing areas. We have also been able to purchase the necessary equipment and signage to cover COVID-19 measures, for when we are able to reopen."

Since its launch in June 2020, the Theatre Reopening Fund, has distributed 75 grants, totalling £301,873 to theatres across the UK.

Theatres Trust Director, Jon Morgan says "We are beginning to look forward to a time when theatres can reopen, welcome audiences back inside and continue to play a vital role in their communities. It has been a difficult year, but Theatres Trust is pleased to have been able to support so many theatres through this grant scheme."
